If you, or your legal dependant, are enrolled in classes, you are eligible for a KCEA Scholarship. Your dependant could receive a \$500 scholarship toward his or her education. If you are enrolled in a class yourself, you may be eligible for a \$250 scholarship to help offset the cost of your education.

Eligibility: Professional Members and/or children (legal dependant) who plan to attend college to advance their educational degree, or any means of higher education.

Requirements:

- Professional Member or child of a professional member
- KCEA Must receive a letter of acceptance before any monies will be distributed
- Scholarship holder must have a G.P.A. of 2.5 or higher
- Must attend a West Virginia Institution of Learning or a College or University with a reciprocal West Virginia agreement.
- Application due to KCEA by April 1, 2016.
